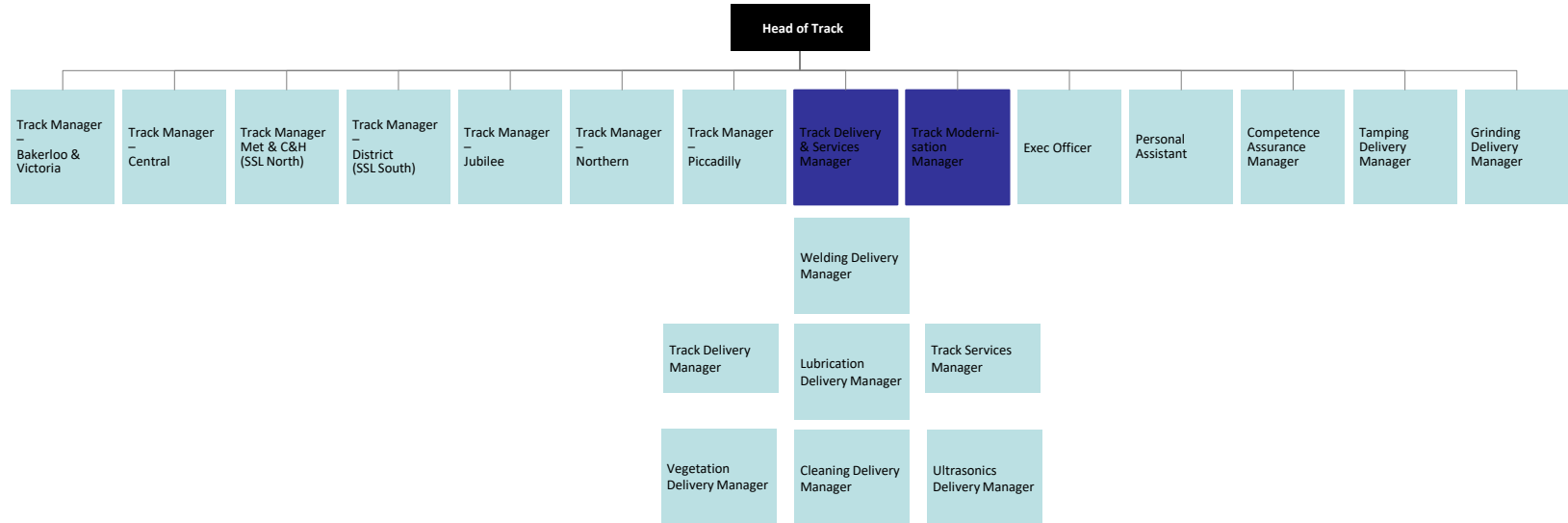

Principles to be applied

- Teams are only to undertake essential maintenance activities, that is, only the activities which assure the Safety of the Line
- Where possible and practicable we will separate individuals from the workplace – for example Inspections (except Ultrasonics) which are a lone working activity, so their people interaction is minimised or eliminated



Principles to be applied

- Where separation is not practicable, for example tasks which through Risk Assessment require more than 1 person (Team) to undertake, we are to ensure that these Teams are separated from other Teams on site (Groups). As an example, for a re-rail which is a Group activity where we will use a Welding Team, a Corrective Maintenance Gang and Signals Support, these respective Teams are to maintain a minimum of 2 metres distance.
- For additional protection, our Teams, where practicable, are to keep a minimum distance of more than 2 metres from each other (no mingling and chatting) and are to be provided with a mask regardless of the Task Risk Assessment.



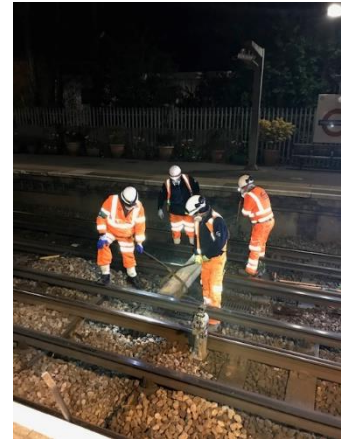
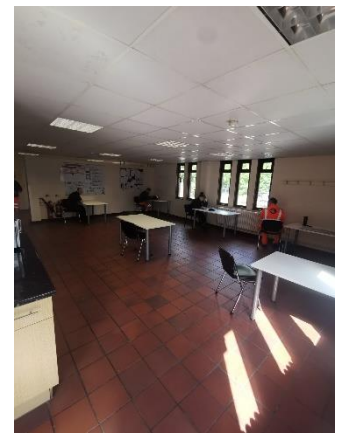
Met/H&C/Circle Line

- Local operational factors
- Two main planning elements
 - Physical - the practical measures we would have to take to protect the staff and keep the trains running.
 - Psychological - how we reassure and support the staff to ensure they remain focused and committed to the task.



Met/H&C/Circle Line

- Physical
 - Essential Tasks:
 - Patrolling, Inspections of P&C and rectification of any faults found within the provisions and timescales of the relevant standards
 - Meetings and briefings
 - Patrolling & Inspections
 - Corrective Maintenance Works



Met/H&C/Circle Line

- Psychological
 - Keeping Staff and their families safe
 - Addressing concerns in an open manner
 - Open discussion, everyone has a voice
 - Townhall meetings without a Townhall
 - Personal touch
 - Maintaining communications with the whole team
