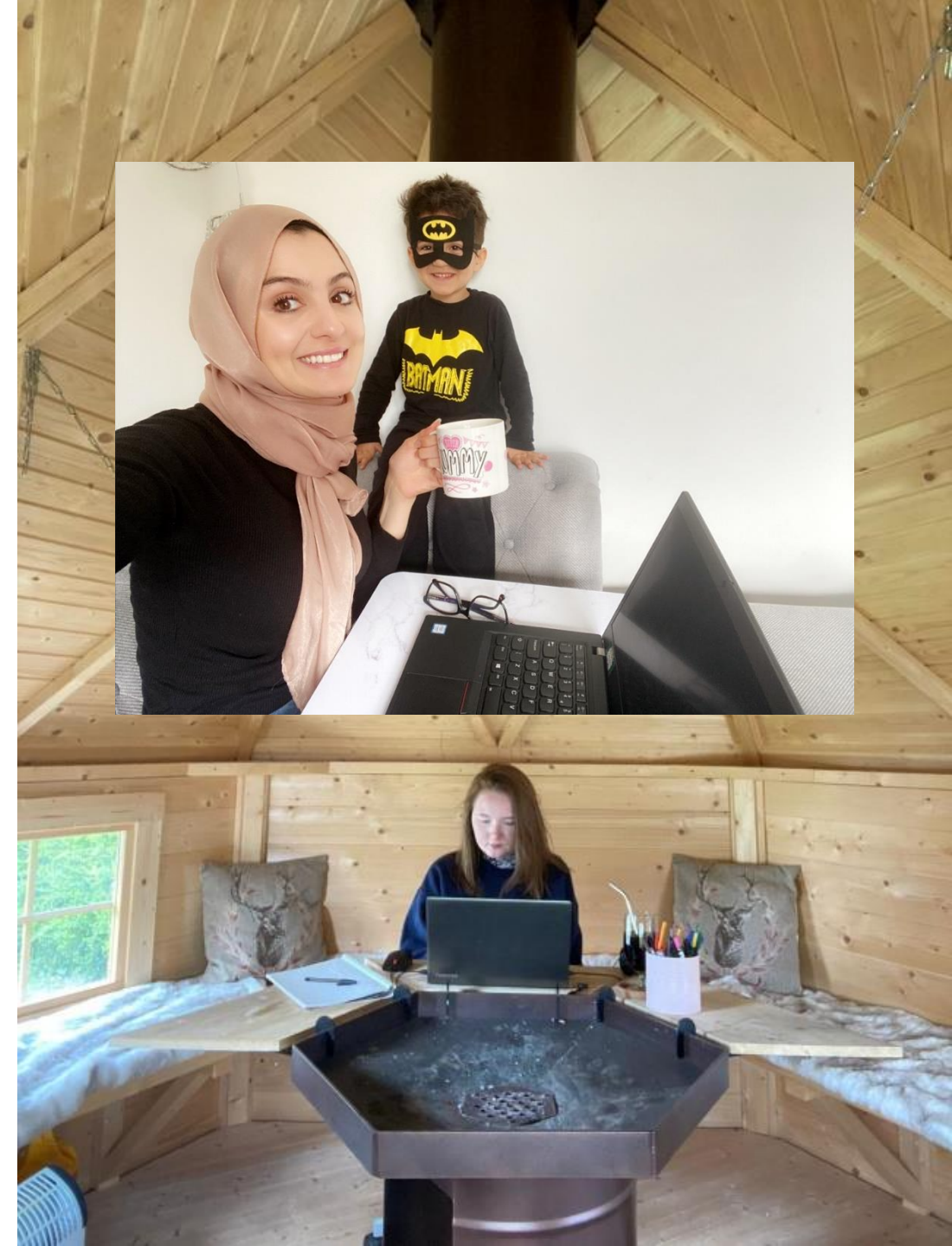
Critical rail schemes

A number of schemes remain crucial to maintaining the safety of the operational railway, particularly earthworks.



Special measures

- Reducing the number of staff in offices by rolling out 'WFH' where practicable
- Preventing 'non-essential' site attendance
- Significant uptake in the use of available technologies e.g. Teams and Skype



Protecting ourselves and others

- Determining which vehicles will be single occupancy and implementing measures in others to maintain 2m+ separation distance between colleagues
- Regular cleaning of vehicles and shared spaces



Changes to working practices

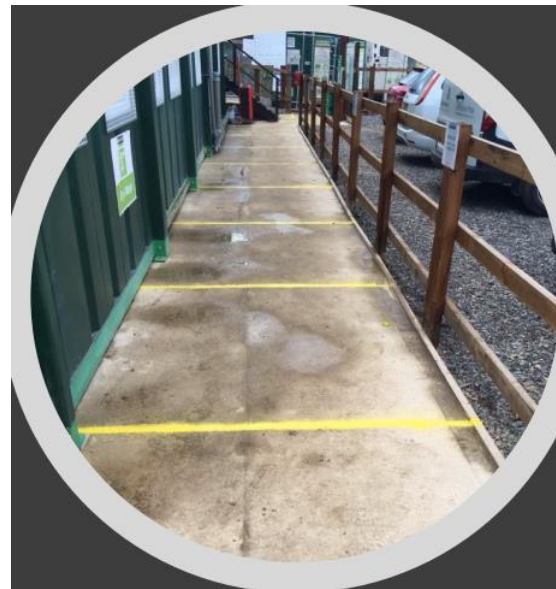
Outdoor Briefings, whilst maintaining 'social distancing' – this increases the challenge to our briefers of ensuring the understanding of the group.





Alterations to our facilities

- Weather-permitting, taking breaks outside
- Keeping the general public at a safe distance
- Increased cleaning of sites
- Staggered break-times
- Additional signage
- Marking 2m bays on walking routes and introducing one-way systems to prevent passing



Keeping safe during works

- Minimum staff on-site
- Maintaining social distancing rules
- All paperwork inclusive of COVID-19 'special measures'
- Using physical demarcation of boundaries where possible



Further measures

- Utilisation of re-useable, personal drinks containers
- Additional PPE and disposal of this in a safe and secure manner
- Introduction of COVID-19 Marshalls
- Forehead strip thermometers issued to individual site staff
- Enhanced contact between teams, functions, line managers and staff to look after each-others wellbeing during this period of enhanced isolation
